TRAFFIC ADVISORY (Amended)

PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE BRIDGE OVER THE RED CEDAR RIVER IS SCHEDULED FOR DECK REPAIRS

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces the following traffic conditions. **Vehicular travel on the Pennsylvania Avenue Bridge over the Red Cedar River will be reduced to two travel lanes for bridge repair beginning on Monday, June 21, 2010.**

Two-way vehicular traffic will be maintained through the construction area. Left turns from the Potter Park Zoo and Lindbergh Drive to southbound Pennsylvania Avenue will be prohibited, along with left turns Beulah Street to northbound Pennsylvanian Avenue. During this construction vehicular traffic requiring access to Potter Park will need to do so by approaching the driveway from the south in the northbound travel lane of Pennsylvania Avenue, it is recommended that motorist follow posted detours for safe travel in this area.

The estimated project completion is September 1, 2010.

Motorists are advised to allow extra time and use alternate route to avoid delays.
