TAX DAY AT THE COLLINS ROAD POST OFFICE

The City of Lansing Department of Planning & Neighborhood Development announces the Lansing Police Department (LPD) has requested following lane restrictions to be in effect on **Wednesday afternoon / evening, April 15, 2009** in order to accommodate the anticipated increase in traffic volumes.

Northbound traffic on Collins Road will be prohibited from making a left hand turn into the Collins Road Post Office Drives.

Collins Road Post Office traffic will be prohibited from turning left onto northbound Collins Road while exiting.

LPD will begin enforcing the above traffic control only if the traffic volumes warrant the above restrictions.

Suggested Route:

Access the Collins Road Post Office from the north by traveling east on Dunckel Road and then traveling south on Collins Road or accessing Collins Road from Forest Road.

Please Note: Depending on construction in the area of Dunckel Road this plan may be altered the day of this event.

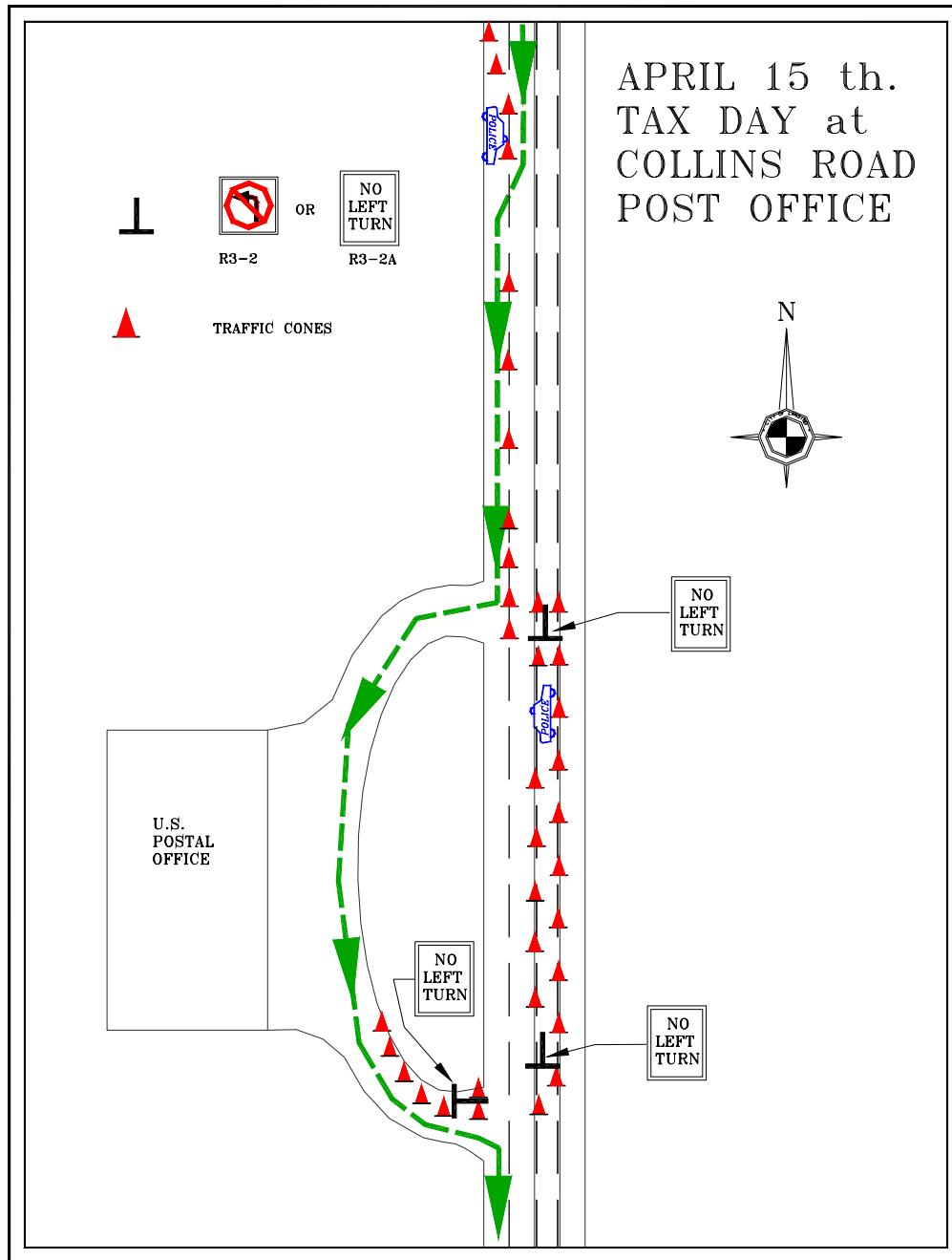
