WALKING/BIKING TASK FORCE TO PRESENT CONCEPT PLAN AND GATHER INPUT AT PUBLIC MEETINGS

The City of Lansing's Task Force on Walking and Biking is holding two non-motorized network plan meetings November 4th and 5th. The goal of the network plan is to provide a framework for creating a comprehensive network of sidewalks, trails, bike lanes, crosswalks and other non-motorized facilities in the city of Lansing.

The meetings will provide an overview of the relation of the non-motorized plan to the City's Parks & Recreation Master Plan and Comprehensive Plan and the work done to date on the non-motorized network plan. Those attending will then be asked to provide: 1) feedback on the concept level non-motorized network plan, 2) input on additional facilities needed to complete the plan and 3) priorities for implementation of the plan.
