## TRAFFIC ADVISORY

### CLOSURE OF WAVERLY/HOLMES INTERSECTION

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that **the intersection of Waverly Road and Holmes Road will be CLOSED TO ALL TRAFFIC starting Monday, July 20, 2009.**

Due to this intersection closure, traffic on Waverly Road between Moores River Drive (Mt. Hope Ave) and Jolly Road will be restricted to local traffic only. Traffic on Holmes Road between Pleasant Grove Road and Waverly Road will also be restricted to local traffic only. Access to the local businesses within this area will be maintained.

The detours associated with this intersection closure are:

#### Northbound Waverly Road

East (right) on Jolly to Pleasant Grove, north (left) on Pleasant Grove to Mt. Hope Avenue, then west (left) on Mt. Hope to return to Waverly Road.

#### Southbound Waverly Road

East (left) on Moores River Drive (Mt. Hope) to Pleasant Grove, south (right) on Pleasant Grove to Mt. Hope Avenue, then west (right) on Jolly Road to return to Waverly Road.

#### Westbound Holmes Road

Use Pleasant Grove to access Jolly Road or Mt. Hope Avenue and continue westbound to Waverly Road.

The Waverly/Holmes intersection will remain closed to through August 2009. Further traffic updates with respect to this project will be provided as appropriate.

Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible.
